Pre-K & K Seats Available

Street Safety

And speaking of safety, please adhere to our drop-off and pick-up procedures as we cooperate with the police to ensure safe transitions. To drop off your children, please pull over to the east side of South Shore Drive, facing north. Please do not execute U-turns. At the end of the day, Pre-K families may park on South Shore Drive in the same manner as drop-off to come inside to pick up their children. K-8 students are picked up at the blacktop. If you arrive early enough to park, please do so that the car will not have to be in reverse when children are in the parking lot. While these guidelines may not be convenient or quick, we feel that our students’ safety takes priority, and we appreciate your understanding.
